 The Greek word translated "blameless" can mean unblemished – no obvious spot. Or it can mean literally unable to of something. Harmlessness is the relational effect of blamelessness. The English word in Philippians 2:15 is translated from a Greek word that describes someone who is innocent or sincere in word and action. As such, the person is pure in their actions towards others – without harm or sincere and innocent of
